Current COVID-19 Guidelines

As more people get vaccinated, we are getting closer and closer to life returning to normal. However, in the meantime, let's stay up to date on the latest CDC guidelines and continue to practice safety measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19.



Stay Home If You Have These Symptoms

- Fever
- Cough
- Colds
- Headache

- Diarrhea
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Joint and Muscle Pain



Have You Been Exposed?

• The CDC defines close contact as being within six feet of an infected individual for a total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period.



Quarantine Guidelines after Positive Test

 Individuals who test positive can end isolation after 10 days, if symptoms were mild, and at least 24 hours have passed without a fever.

Quarantine Guidelines after Exposure

 Individuals exposed to COVID-19 can end isolation after 7 days if they have no symptoms and received a negative test 5 days (or later) after being exposed.
