AVOIDING VIRUS RISKS

States may be reopening and employees going back to work but that doesn't mean coronavirus risks have gone away. The virus is still here and it is still spreading, so we need to recognize and avoid situations that put you and those around you at the greatest risk.

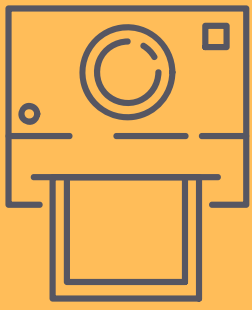
We must go back to work SAFELY. Our number one priority is minimizing risk to employees and customers.

DO YOUR PART AND WEAR A MASK TO REDUCE WHAT YOU RELEASE INTO THE ENVIRONMENT. IT HELPS EVERYONE.

- The main sources for infection are home, workplace, public transport, social gatherings, and restaurants. This accounts for 90% of all transmission events.
- Your sneezes and your coughs expel so much virus that you can infect a whole room of people.
- **This is why it is absolutely vital that anyone experiencing symptoms MUST STAY HOME.**
- Being in an enclosed space, sharing the same air for a prolonged period increases your chances of exposure and infection.
- The less time you spend talking with someone reduces the amount of virus shared with you or that you share with someone else.
- Outbreaks spread from shopping appear to be responsible for only a small percentage of traced infections.
- Outdoor environments are safer. The infinite outdoor space for viral dilution reduces viral load. The effects of sunlight, heat, and humidity on viral survival, all serve to minimize the risk to everyone when outside.

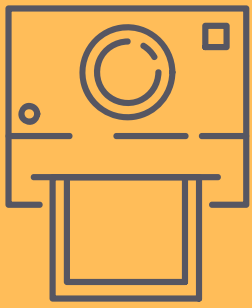

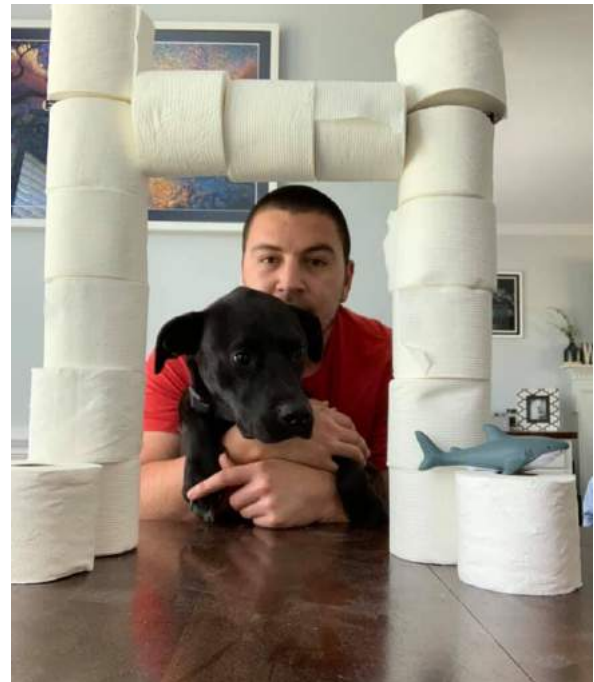
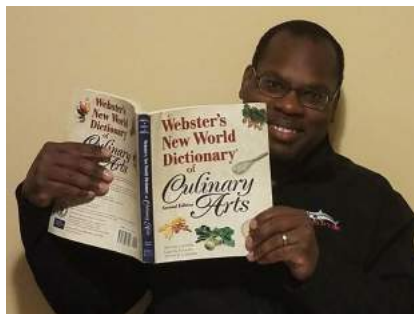
